
Sub : Issuance of "No Objection Certificate cum Certificate of Recognition" In favour "THE BANDHAN SCHOOL ARANGHATA", Anandanagar, Radhakantapur, P.S - Taherpur, Ranaghat, District- Nadia, PIN- 741501, WEST BENGAL.


As per decision of the State Level Committee constituted under the provisions of Rule 10 of West Bengal Right of Children to free & Compulsory Education Rules, 2012 in its meeting dated-31-01-2024 and as per approval of the competent authority, "No Objection Certificate Cum Certificate of Recognition" as an unaided school for class I(One) to class VIII (Eight) in respect "THE BANDHAN SCHOOL ARANGHATA", Anandanagar, Radhakantapur, P.S - Taherpur, Ranaghat, District- Nadia, PIN- 741501, WEST BENGAL is hereby given for the purpose of preparing its candidates to appear in the final examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education Examination, subject to observance of the following terms and conditions, failing which the "No Objection Certificate cum Certificate Of Recognition" issued in favour of the school may be withdrawn.

1. That the school authority shall maintain and fulfil all the conditions all the time as mentioned in Rule 10(15) of the WBRTE Rules, 2012.
2. That the school authority shall never claim any financial assistance from State Govt.
3. That the school shall be located in a relatively noise free and pollution free area having adequate supply of drinking water and electricity.
4. That the school shall have classroom of adequate space commensurate with the enrolment which is comfortable and suitable for imparting lesson and not less than the number of class units.
5. That the school have a playground for the students and a barrier free access.
6. That the school shall have separate toilet for the boys and girls in case of co-ed school) and teachers.

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24. That the 10%(ten percent) of the new admission in the school in each academic year will be allowed on the recommendation of the School Education Directorate, W.B. and 50%(fifty percent) of such students will have to be allowed to prosecute studies in the school free of cost.
25. That the school conforms to seeks to and has a curriculum to implement the values enshrined in the Constitution of India and promote respect for the National Anthem, National Flag, National Emblem and National Integration.
26. That the school authority shall ensure that there shall not be any activity in the school which may create acrimonious feelings or division among students on the basis of caste, creed, race or religion.


